8/5/2009 (Erie, PA) — A future Erie lawyer who will be attending law school at the University of Pittsburgh this fall is the 2009 recipient of the Chief Justice Samuel J. Roberts Scholarship.

Holly M. Forsberg, who earned her undergraduate degree in business administration and marketing from Pitt earlier this year, was one of 13 aspirants for the scholarship, administered and awarded for the Roberts Family by the Erie County Bar Foundation.

The Chief Justice Samuel J. Roberts Scholarship Committee found that while competition for the 2009 scholarship award was extremely keen, Forsberg exemplified the many qualities demonstrated by the scholarship's namesake who, during his long and distinguished career as an Erie lawyer and judge, rose to lead the Commonwealth's highest court and become one of the nation's most respected jurists.

In addition to awarding the 2009 first year scholarship to Forsberg, the committee authorized renewal of Erie's Denise Christine Cady's Roberts Scholarship as she enters her third year at Case Western Reserve Law School, citing her academic success.

Meanwhile, Forsberg was selected after the committee interviewed all 13 scholarship candidates.
